



LOGISTICS

Our instructors meet your students in a space on-site at your school for an hour and a half of after school activities designed specifically for them! Class meets 1-2 times per week for 12-16 weeks at a time with no less than six and no more than ten children and two-three instructors (3:1 child-to-teacher ratio). Tuition includes all materials, special events, and instructor fees. Instructors dismiss all children to care providers at the end of each session. We collaborate with school clinicians and parents monthly to continue interventions and plans throughout the semester.

VISION

Quad on Campus seeks to provide functional, convenient opportunities for 2e children and their peers in the community immediately following their school day. Children engage in the traditional 'Quad Squad' class model, led by psychosocial 2e experts, which introduces social/emotional learning skills woven into unique mixed-media projects that are completely interest-based and, most of all, FUN!

ACTIVITIES

Children create at Quad on Campus. With projects designed for the gifted learner that hone social/emotional and executive functioning strategies, each child brings home more than they would from a typical arts-and-crafts play group.

INSTRUCTORS

Psychosocial (Core) teachers at Quad on Campus have backgrounds ranging from gifted and special education, speech and language therapy, social work, mental health, and more. Plus, they are trained and supervised by the 2e experts at The Quad Manhattan.
